

## From Vancouver, British Columbia

Distance : 438 miles (705 kilometres)

Drive Time : Approximately 10 hours on winter roads



- Start going east on W 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue toward Yukon Street. (2.3 miles / 4 kilometres).
- W 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue becomes S Grandview Highway (1.8 miles / 3 kilometres).
- Merge onto Provincial Route 1 E / Trans-Canada Highway E (88.1 miles / 142 kilometres).
- Provincial Route 1 E / Trans-Canada Highway E becomes Provincial Route 3 E / Crowsnest Highway E (4 miles / 6.5 kilometres).
- Take Provincial Route 5 / Coquihalla Highway toward Merritt / Kelowna / Kamloops (0.2 miles / 320 metres).
- Stay straight to go onto Provincial Route 5 N / Coquihalla Highway N (Portions Toll) (67.7 miles / 109 kilometres).
- Take the Highway 97 C / Highway 5A exit – Exit 286 – toward Kelowna / Merritt / Highway 8 / Spences Bridge (0.1 miles / 160 metres).
- Take the Highway 5A S / Highway 97C E ramp (less than 0.1 miles / 160 metres).
- Merge on to Provincial Route 97C E (65 miles / 102 kilometres).
- Take the Highway 97 N exit on the left toward Westbank / Kelowna / Vernon (0.6 miles / 970 metres).
- Merge onto Provincial Route 97 N (43 miles / 69 kilometres).
- Turn right on to Provincial Route 6 / 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue (0.1 miles / 160 metres).
- Turn right on to 30<sup>th</sup> Street / Provincial Route 6. Continue to follow Provincial Route 6. (83.5 miles / 134 kilometres).
- Provincial Route 6 becomes Needles-Fauquier Ferry (leaves every half an hour on the hour and at half-past) (0.7 miles / 1.13 kilometres).
- Needles-Fauquier Ferry becomes Provincial Route 6 (35.4 miles / 57 kilometres).
- Turn right to stay on Provincial Route 6 (24.7 miles / 39.75 kilometres).
- Turn right to stay on Provincial Route 6 (0.2 miles / 320 metres).
- Turn right to stay on Provincial Route 6 (3.3 miles / 5.31 kilometres).
- Turn right to stay on Provincial Route 6 (0.3 miles / 480 metres).
- From New Denver take Highway No. 31A to Kaslo, BC.
- Retallack Lodge is located at the top of the pass and is approximately 26 kilometres from New Denver. Retallack's timberframe sign is on the right hand side of the highway just past the yellow road closure gates.
